Casual laborers from all over India lived in slums around various industries which have been setup in Mundra, Kutch, Gujarat. They did not have access to basic amenities like clean drinking water and sanitation facilities. Their children were unable to get admission because they did not have permanent address, did not know Gujarati and were working as rag pickers. That is why Dhan Vallabh, in association with YMC Kutch took initiative to start Hindi Medium School namely "Vallabh Vidyalaya" at village Shiracha-Kutch in December 2016. Presently Vallabh Vidyalaya has 85 students.

There are no benches for the students to sit on and there is no storage space. It is simply an empty room with a carpet and a chalk board.
